Christ Made Peace

Colossians 1:20 *and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross.*

- This world stole our peace.
- Christ made peace by His death on the cross.
- Without the manger there would be no cross.

Christ Gives Peace

John 14:27 *Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.*

- Peace is not partisan
Ephesians 2:19 Consequently, you are no longer foreigners and strangers, but fellow citizens with God's people and also members of his household,
- Jesus restores peace to the disrespected.
- Did you know that shepherd in the first century despised as dirty, seedy and of questionable moral character?
- Jesus called himself a shepherd.

Christ Is Our Peace

Ephesians 2:14 *For he himself is our peace...*

- To have true peace we must have Christ, for He *is* our peace.
- If we are to have His peace, He must have us.
- Peace is a person.

Take this with you...

- The deeper we go in in our relationship with Christ, the more peace we will experience.
- At Christmas we celebrate the Prince of Peace, who came to give peace to the weary.
- Through Christ we are no longer at war with God, but are now His sons and daughters.
